The Allegan County Health Department has received a limited amount of vaccine for the H1N1 influenza virus. Much of this has been distributed to local care providers, clinics, and pharmacies in Allegan County. Allegan county residents, you are asked to check with your care provider or pharmacy to find out the availability of the vaccine and schedule with them if at all possible.

If your provider or local pharmacy does not have vaccine, the Allegan County Health Department has limited vaccine for the following groups:

Pregnant women,
Persons 6 months to 24 years of age with chronic medical conditions, and
Caregivers and siblings of infants 6 months of age or younger,

who can not get the vaccine from their medical provider.

If you are a person 6 months to 24 years of age with chronic medical conditions, you will need to have an authorization from your physician before you receive the vaccine.

The Clinic is by appointment only. The clinic will be held at the Allegan Health Department facility at 3255 122nd. Av. Allegan, in Suite 200.

Clinic hours will be Tuesday October 27, 2009 through Friday, October 30, 2009 from 5:00 pm until 8:00 pm and Monday November 1, 2009 through Friday, November 6, 2009 from 5:00 pm until 8:00 pm.

You must call (269) 673-5411 and ask to make an H1N1 vaccine appointment. You will not be seen without an appointment

The Allegan Health Department will expand these clinic dates and hours as more vaccine is received.

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
