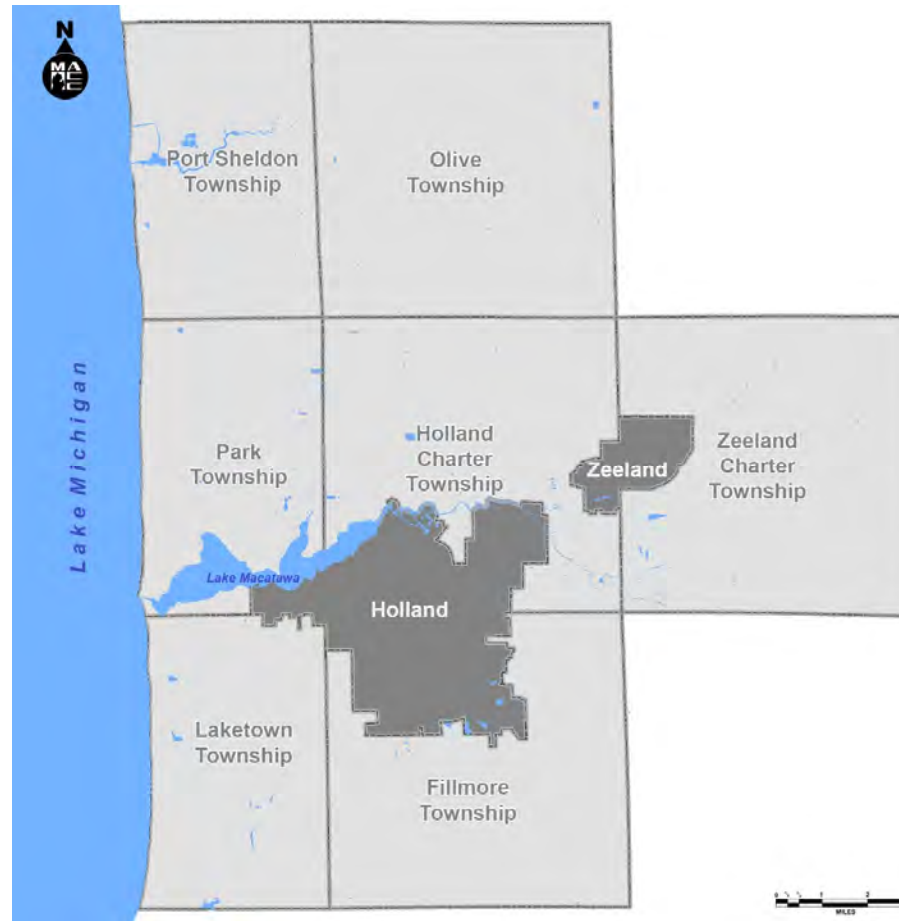
FILLMORE TOWNSHIP



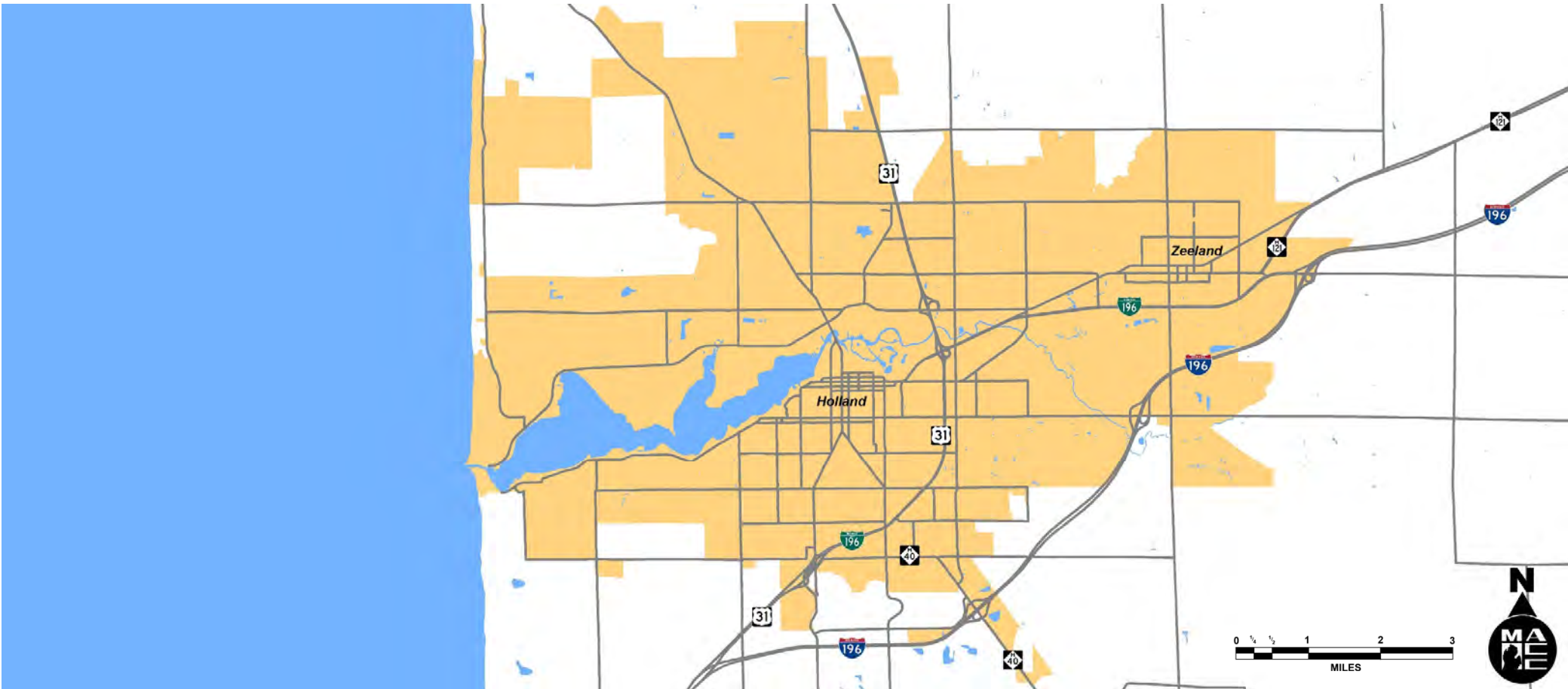
Laketown Township

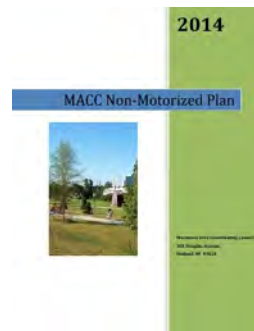

Environmental (2022)

- On Behalf of the MACC, ODC Has Administered Over **\$1 Million** in Grants to Protect Waterways
- Saved **357 Tons** of Sediment From Entering Local Waterways (Ongoing)
- Over **1.2 Million** Gallons of Rain Runoff Treated (Ongoing)
- Supported **46 Clean-Up Events** That Removed **3,661 Pounds** of Trash From Local Waterways

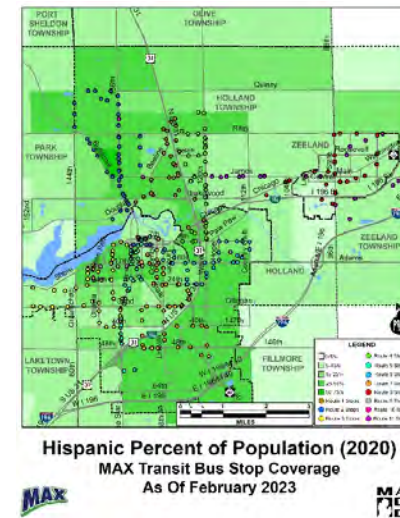
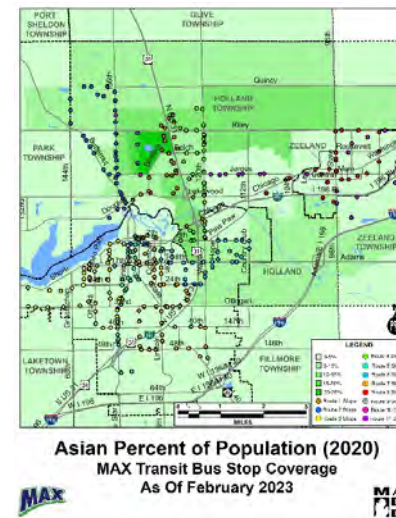
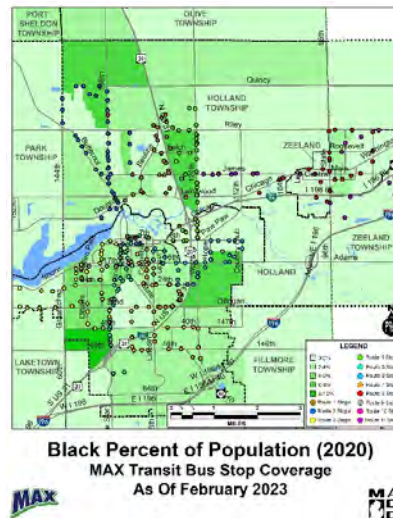
Business Loop I-196 Study
