

All containers other than Republic Services carts will not be picked up. All recycling must be placed loose inside the cart; no material outside the cart will be picked up.

All bulk trash needs to be curbside on the ground. Collection material must be either contained or managed by driver. All bulk material must be bagged; no loose material. No trailers will be unloaded; must be on the ground.

Gift bags (laminated, coated or dyed)

Household cleaners

Liquids of any kind

Medical waste

Packing peanuts (polystyrene foam)

Paint or oil cans

Plastic bags

Polystyrene foam

Propane tanks

Ribbons and bows

Trash of any kind
