Recycling Information

Residents can drop off single stream commingled recycling at the Casco Twp. Recycling and Transfer station.

This site is under surveillance and residents that leave trash, furniture, appliances, paint, and other materials not listed increase the expense of this station.

What to bring

- Cardboard & Paper board
- Magazines, newsprint, paper, & junk mail
- Cartons
- Glass bottles & jars
- Plastic containers #1-7
- Metal cans, pie plates, & foil



- Empty containers
- Rinse & dry containers
- Leave the caps on
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Respect the recycling station & property
- Follow the guidelines



- No food or soiled items
- No hazardous materials
- No large plastic items
- No clothes
- No plastic bags
- No styrofoam



Residents are able to recycle:

- major appliances
- stoves
- microwaves
- dishwashers
- refrigerator
- (4) car or truck tires per year
- TV/Computer
- other electronic devices

Please check with attendant for more information.

There is a one (1) TV and two (2) Computer Monitor limit per calendar year.

HHW can be dropped off by appointment at the Allegan County Health Department. Contact 269-673-5415 to schedule an appointment.
