The Recycling Station

Residents can drop off single stream recycling at the Cheshire Township Transfer Station, 4120 106th Avenue.

Friday, 2:00pm to 5:00pm

Saturday, 10:am to 5:00pm

This site is under surveillance and residents that leave trash, furniture, appliances, paint, and other materials not listed increase the expense of this station.

What to bring

- Cardboard & Paper board
- Magazines, newsprint, paper, & junk mail
- Cartons
- Glass bottles & jars
- Plastic containers #1-7
- Metal cans, pie plates, & foil

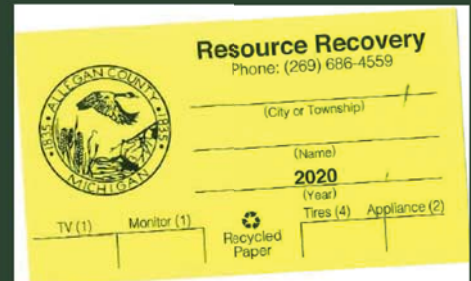


- Empty containers
- Rinse & dry containers
- Leave the caps on
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Respect the recycling station & property
- Follow the guidelines



- No food or soiled items
- No hazardous materials or electronics
- No large plastic items
- No clothes
- No plastic bags
- No styrofoam
