Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Batteries, oil based paints, pesticides, solvents, fluorescent bulbs, cleaners, sharps and other chemicals can be dropped off by appointment at the Health Department.

Battery Recycling

A battery bucket is located at City Hall. No auto batteries. Broken Arrow Recycling (1100 Lincoln Rd) pays residents for their auto batteries and for scrap metal.
