### Recycling Information

The recycling collection is every 4th Wednesday. Please check the recycling calendar for actual dates. Remember to place your cart out the night before your scheduled pick-up.

- Heath Township residents are eligible for curbside recycling service. Sign up by contacting Allegan County Resource Recovery at (269) 686-4559
- Residents may also contact Republic Services at (877) 698-7274 to report a missed pickup.



- **Empty containers**

- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Respect the recycling station & property















### **Regional Recyling** Depots:

Your Resource Recovery Card allows you to recycle: tires (4), styrofoam, appliances (2) (stoves, microwaves, dishwasher, refrigerator), TV/ Computer, and metal.

- \$alem Township Transfer Station, 4145 29th Street open from 8:00am-3:30pm. (\$3/TV recycling fee; site also provides bulk trash service for a fee.)
- Broken Arrow Recycling, 1100 Lincoln Rd, Allegan, open Tuesday - Friday 9-4:30pm and Saturday 9-1:00pm. visit www.barecycling.com for more information.

- Metal cans, pie plates, & foil
