### Recycling Information

Leighton Township residents are eligible for curbside recycling service. Sign up by contacting Arrowwaste at (616) 748-1955

- The recycling collection is **every other week on Monday**. Remember to place your cart out the night before your scheduled pick-up.
- Residents may also contact Arrowwaste to report a missed pickup.

#### What to recycle

- Cardboard & Paper board
- Magazines, newsprint, paper, & junk mail
- Cartons
- Glass bottles & jars
- Plastic containers #1-7
- Metal cans, pie plates, & foil



- Empty containers
- Rinse & dry containers
- Leave the caps on
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Respect the recycling station & property



- No food or soiled items
- No hazardous materials
- No large plastic items
- No clothes
- No plastic bags
- No styrofoam

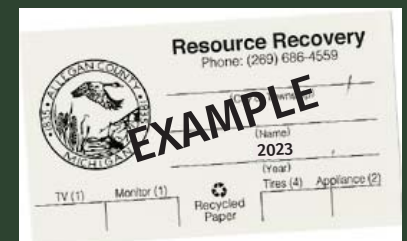


### Regional Recycling Depots:

Your Resource Recovery Card allows you to recycle: tires (4), styrofoam, appliances (2) (stoves, microwaves, dishwasher, refrigerator), TV/ Computer, and metal.

Salem Township Transfer Station is open the \*1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month (Closed Jan & Feb)

- Salem Township Transfer Station, 4145 29th Street is open from 8:00am-3:30pm. (\$3/TV recycling fee; site also provides bulk trash service for a fee.)
- Broken Arrow Recycling, 1100 Lincoln Rd, Allegan, is open Tuesday - Friday 9-4:30pm and Saturday 9-1:00pm. Visit [www.barecycling.com](http://www.barecycling.com) for more information.



2024 Resource Recovery Cards are available for pick-up at Leighton Township Hall, please contact at (616) 891-8238. This card is required to receive depot services.
