Recycling Information

Leighton Township residents are eligible for curbside recycling service. Sign up by contacting Arrowaste at (616) 748-1955

- The recycling collection is every other week on Monday. Remember to place your cart out the night before your scheduled pick-up.
- Residents may also contact Arrowaste to report a missed pickup.



What to recycle

Cardboard & Paper board

- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Respect the recycling station & property



- No food or soiled items
- No hazardous materials
- No large plastic items
- No clothes
- No plastic bags
- No styrofoam



Regional Recyling Depots:

Your Resource Recovery Card allows you to recycle: tires (4), styrofoam, appliances (2) (stoves, microwaves, dishwasher, refrigerator), TV/ Computer, and metal.

- Salem Township Transfer Station, 4145 29th Street is open from 8:00am-3:30pm. (\$3/TV recycling fee; site also provides bulk trash service for a fee.)
- Broken Arrow Recycling, 1100
 Lincoln Rd, Allegan, is open Tuesday - Friday 9-4:30pm and Saturday 9-1:00pm. Visit www.barecycling.com for more information.
