What to recycle

- Cardboard & Paper board
- Magazines, newsprint, paper, & junk mail
- Cartons
- Glass bottles & jars
- Plastic containers #1-7
- Metal cans, pie plates, & foil

Manlius township residents may drop off single-stream recycling at Manlius Twp. Hall located at 3134 57th St., Fennville.

Residents that leave trash, furniture, appliances, and paint increase the expense of this station.



- Empty containers
- Rinse & dry containers
- Leave the caps on
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Respect the recycling station & property









- NO food or soiled items
- NO hazardous materials
- NO large plastic items
- NO clothes
- NO plastic bags
- NO styrofoam









Regional Recyling Depots:

Your Resource Recovery Card allows you to recycle: tires (4), styrofoam, appliances (2) (stoves, microwaves, dishwasher, refrigerator), TV/Computer, and metal.
