Recycling Information

Salem Township residents are eligible for curbside recycling service. Sign-up by contacting Allegan County Resource Recovery at (269) 673-5415 or Salem Township Hall at (616) 896-9857.

- Place carts out the night before your scheduled pickup. Only recycling items inside the carts will be picked up. Do not put bags next to carts.

What to recycle

- Cardboard & Paper board
- Magazines, newsprint, paper, & junk mail
- Cartons
- Glass bottles & jars
- Plastic containers #1-7
- Metal cans, pie plates, & foil





- No food or soiled items
- No hazardous materials
- No large plastic items
- No clothes
- No plastic bags
- No styrofoam



- Empty containers
- Rinse & dry containers
- Leave the caps on
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Respect the recycling station & property

















Regional Recyling Depots:

Your Resource Recovery Card allows you to recycle: tires (4), styrofoam, appliances (2) (stoves, microwaves, dishwasher, refrigerator), TV/Computer, and metal.

Salem Township Transfer Station is open the *1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month (Closed Jan & Feb)

- Salem Township Transfer Station, 4145 29th St is open from 8:00am-3:30pm. (\$3/TV recyling fee; site also provides bulk trash service for a fee.
