Recycling Station

Trowbridge residents may drop off single-stream recycling at Trowbridge Twp. Recycling Station next to Township Hall, located at: 913 S M-40 Hwy. You must bring your Resource Recovery card.

HOURS:

- Tuesdays: 2:00pm - 5:00pm
- Thursdays: 9:00am - 12:00pm
- Saturdays: 9:00am - 12:00pm

Residents that leave trash, furniture, appliances and paint increase the expense of this station. Obey the guidelines!

What to recycle

- Cardboard & Paper board
- Magazines, newsprint, paper, & junk mail
- Cartons
- Glass bottles & jars
- Plastic containers #1-7
- Metal cans, pie plates, & foil



- No food or soiled items
- No hazardous materials
- No large plastic items
- No clothes
- No plastic bags
- No styrofoam



- Empty containers
- Rinse & dry containers
- Leave the caps on
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Respect the recycling station & property



Obey the guidelines!

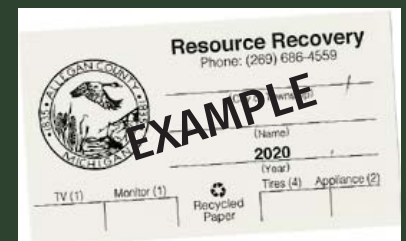
Contaminated recycling ends up in landfills and increases overall recycling costs.

Regional Recycling Depots:

Your Resource Recovery Card allows you to recycle: tires (4), styrofoam, appliances (2) (stoves, microwaves, dishwasher, refrigerator), TV/ Computer, and metal.

Salem Township Transfer Station is open the *1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month (closed Jan and Feb)

- Salem Township Transfer Station, 4145 29th Street is open from 8:00am-3:30pm. (\$3/TV recycling fee; site also provides bulk trash service for a fee.)
- Broken Arrow Recycling, 1100 Lincoln Rd, Allegan, open Tuesday - Friday 9-4:30pm and Saturday 9-1:00pm. Visit www.barecycling.com for more information.
