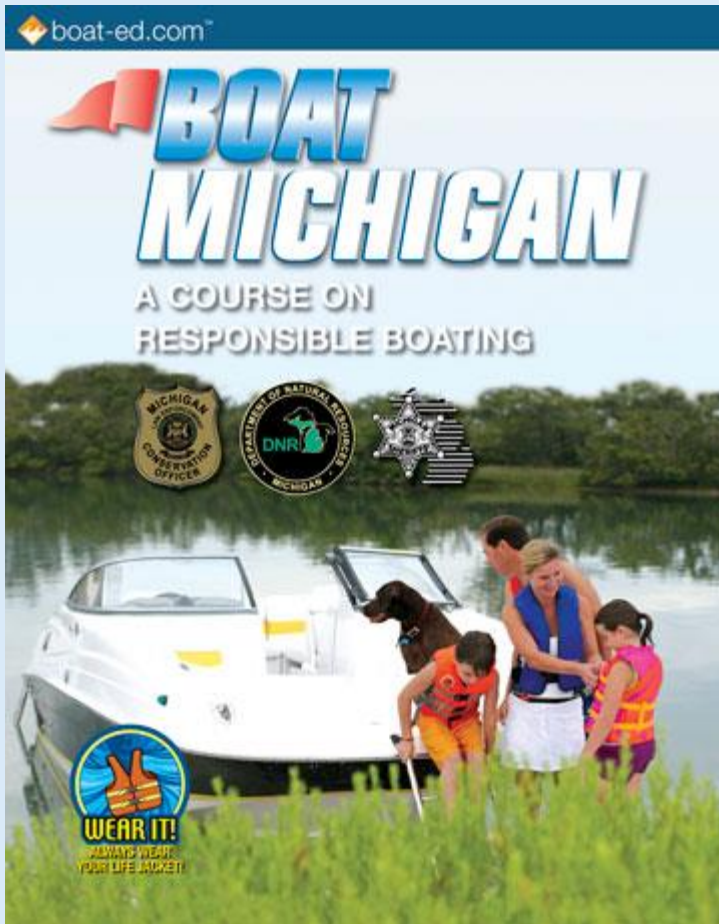


Spring ahead with a BOATER SAFETY COURSE

The Allegan County Sheriff's Office will once again be offering several Boater Safety Courses this spring and summer to help people be ready for the upcoming boating season.

Boater safety classes are taught annually throughout Allegan County by Marine Deputies allowing students to earn their Boating Safety Certificate.

Upon the successful completion of this class, attendees will receive their Boater's Safety Certificate allowing them to operate a motorboat or PWC in the State of Michigan.

Boater Safety is not only a good idea but is a legal requirement. Classroom learning has the benefits of live instructor based learning, one-on-one assistance and the ability for students to ask questions and seek clarification on various topics.

- Classes run April – July each year
