ORDER OF NECESSITY

A meeting having been held by the Board of Determination, composed of Michael VanDenBerg, Stephen Schulz, Pam Brown, and Roger VanVolkinberg, Alternate, at 3:30 p.m. on Wednesday, December 13, 2023 at Cultivate Church, 4872 136th Avenue, Hamilton, Michigan, being the time and place fixed in the Notice of Meeting of Board of Determination, notice was duly served, published and posted as required by law; and at said meeting Mike Van den Berg was elected Chairperson and Pam Brown was elected Secretary, and all persons owning lands liable to assessment for benefits or whose lands shall be crossed by said drain and any district or municipality affected having been given an opportunity to appear and be heard on the question being considered of whether the drain prayed for in a Freeholders of the Township Petition for the locating, establishing, and constructing a county drain to be known as the Hamilton Drain, is necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare in accordance with Chapter 4 of Public Act No. 40 40, P.A. 1956, as amended; and the Board of Determination after having heard the evidence offered and having made its determination upon the necessity of the drain and whether the same is necessary and conducive to public health, convenience of welfare;

It Is Hereby Ordered and Determined that the drain to be known as Hamilton Drain as prayed for in the Petition dated July 11, 2023 (check one) is **is** **not** necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare.
