#### ORDER OF PUBLIC HEALTH DETERMINATION

**WHEREAS**, a petition, dated February 8, 2023, has been made and filed with the Allegan County Drain Commissioner for the location, establishment and construction of the Myrtle Drain pursuant to Chapter 4 of Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended; and

**WHEREAS**, the petition was signed by Laketown Township, a municipality liable for an assessment for the location, establishment and construction the proposed Myrtle Drain; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Determination, at a meeting held on May 16, 2023, by a majority vote of the Board, determined that the proposed drain is necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience, or welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Myrtle Drain having been determined to be necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience, or welfare, I do hereby determine that the location, establishment and construction of the Myrtle Drain shall benefit public health in the following cities, townships and villages that shall be liable for an at-large assessment:
