## **Order of Practicability**

## DUNCAN LAKE INTERCOUNTY DRAIN

(Barry, Allegan and Kent Counties)

WHEREAS, the Duncan Lake Intercounty Drain Drainage Board met on December 7, 2021 to consider the petition, dated April 12, 2021, for maintenance and improvement of an intercounty drain pursuant to Chapter 8 of Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended, to determine the sufficiency of the petition to convey jurisdiction, go over the route of the intercounty drain, and to further determine whether the maintenance and improvement of the intercounty drain is practicable; and

WHEREAS, said Drainage Board after hearing the evidence offered made its determination upon the sufficiency of the petition and whether the proposed drain project is practicable.

IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED AND DETERMINED by a majority vote of the Drainage Board that the proposed drain project as set forth in the petition is practicable.
