The Allegan County Drain Commissioner will meet on the above date, time, and location to receive construction bids for the Monterey Lake Dam. Bids will then be opened and publicly announced. Bids will be accepted through paper submission only.

The Monterey Lake Dam project will be let in 1 section as follows, each section having the length, average depth and width as set forth:

Installation of approximately 140 feet of 6'x5' box culvert with an average depth of 9 feet, installation of a 12' diameter manhole. Flowable filling a portion of the existing 54" CMP outlet pipe. Project also includes removing existing concrete slabs on dam embankment and replacing with approximately 2,300 sq. yds. of riprap.

This Notice of Letting, the plans, specifications and bid proposal shall be considered a part of the Contract. The Contract will be let in accordance with the Contract Documents now on file at Allegan County Drain Commissioner's Office and available to interested parties. Bids will be made and received in accordance with these documents. Bidding Documents, including plans and specifications, may be examined at the following locations:

A <u>mandatory</u> pre-bid conference will be held on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>June 18, 2024</u>, at 10 a.m. at the Monterey Lake Dam (28th Street Park entrance between 136th & 137th Avenues). If raining heavy, we'll meet at the Sandy Pines Administration Building (2745 136th Avenue, Hopkins, MI 49328) with an optional site visit to follow.

Copies of Bidding Documents may only be obtained at the mandatory pre-bid conference.

A security deposit in the amount of 5% of the total bid shall be submitted in the form of a cashier's check, money order, certified check, or bidder's bond with any bid. No cash will be permitted. The security deposits of all unsuccessful bidders shall be returned after the Contract is awarded.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work and meeting all conditions represented in the Instructions to Bidders. The Contract completion date and the terms of payment will be announced at the time and place of letting. If no satisfactory bids are received, we reserve the right to reject any and all bids and to adjourn to a time and location as we shall announce.
