 - a. Review Quarter Revenue Comparisons

Gildea reviewed 1st and 2nd quarter's revenue and budgets. Everything is on track. No new expenditures outside of everyday use. We actioned off old equipment and received a check for over 22,000 from Bidergy. This will go into the parks capital and covers the costs of future capital. Quarterly comparisons show we are off to a great start.

- 1. 2025-2029 Recreation Plan <u>2020-2024 Recreation Plan</u>
 - Gildea discusses the Recreation Plan and reviews Section 7, Action Program. Clark asks that we add Littlejohn walking trails to the first page as an accomplishment. The needs and wants of the county are defined, from collaboration and volunteers, programming for park users, and the long-term forest management plan. Each Park's needs have been identified and listed out. The 2021 Special Review is listed out following the needs lists. This shows the park's priority projects and was integral to the Board of Commissioners's decisions regarding the parks. The Parks board suggests this section may not be needed. The 2025-2029 Priority list, focuses on top identified projects that need to be completed.
 - DeYoung discusses how in other communities there are big companies looking to put their name out, Allegan isn't as lucky to have bigger companies. Smaller companies are being hit up for all the small events on a regular basis. Discusses receiving revenue from things like people who pass away and want to donate to an endowment fund for the parks. The Board of Commissioners made a shift years ago to no longer fund parks through the general fund and only utilize funds from Shared Casino funds.

A Motion Jessup, seconded by Clark to recommended sending the priority list, even though we have not finished the process of approving the recreation plan, to the BOC for review and this draft to go to the public after the final proofreading. The motion carried.
