## **Summary**

Conducts epidemiological surveillance for all areas including, but not limited to communicable and chronic diseases, reproductive health, child health, and injuries (unintentional and intentional). Compiles, analyzes, and interprets the data for the community and others in the department. Performs related work as assigned.

#### **Essential Functions**

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Collects, compiles, analyzes and evaluates data to assess the health status of the population and specific demographic groups to include the community health needs assessments and community health improvement plans.
- 2. Identifies demographic, geographic, cultural and other variables linked to the incidence of communicable and chronic diseases to identify sources of exposure, disease transmission and risk factors and to predict the probability of future occurrences of disease.
- 3. Develops epidemiological assessments and applies epidemiological principles to acute and chronic disease control activities including outbreak situations.
- 4. Maintains the epidemiological database for the Allegan County Health Department.
- 5. Interacts directly with the Health Officer in providing disease updates and in obtaining specific direction in disease investigation, prevention and control activities.
- 6. Conducts disease control activities as needed with Environmental Health particularly in the food borne and zoonotic illnesses or chronic diseases such as asthma.
- 7. Participates in the development of programs and strategies to prevent communicable and chronic diseases in the general public and among high-risk populations.
- 8. Prepares reports for the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services using local data and prepares reports from state data for local use in a timely manner.

- 9. Relates to the Board of Commissioners, professional and community groups on population health, disease control and general epidemiological related matters.
- 10. Promotes evidence-based interventions and shares with practitioners and community stakeholders.
- 11. Assist with emergency preparedness activities as needed.
