Summary

Under administrative direction of the Health Officer, this position is responsible for overseeing the development and evaluation of standards of medical care throughout the agency, providing medical direction to the agency's personal and environmental staff, and advising the Health Officer in matters of medical policy. Establishing and maintaining effective working relationships with representatives of professional societies and health agencies at the local, state and federal level to insure the compliance of the County's various health programs with national and statewide medical guidelines are major aspects of the work.

Essential Functions

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- 1. As part of the Public Health Administrative Team provides feedback on development, planning, and implementation of public health services.
- 2. Consults with and advises public health professionals, and team members on public health medical and policy matters. Interfaces with and acts as liaison to the public, private and non-profit health care sector to improve public health outcomes.
- 3. Acts as medical liaison to other local health departments, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, health systems and other providers, and local medical societies.
- 4. Establishes and implements policies, procedures and standing orders to ensure that all Public Health medical practices and services comply with statutory requirements, best evidenced based practice, ethics, and quality and accreditation standards.
- 5. Assists in the enforcement of state laws and local regulations pertaining to public health.
- 6. Assist the Health Officer in the strategic short and long term planning efforts for the Public Health Department and provides leadership in policy development and coordination of the provision of health care services on a community-wide basis.
- 7. Assists the Public Health in public health investigations.

- 8. Provides overall direction for physicians, nurses and other health professionals in local health department programs relative to medical policies and procedures.
- 9. Provide expert medical direction in disease, illness, and environmental harm control. Act under the direction of the Health Officer in times of a disaster utilizing medical expertise.
