- i. Complete notice to proceed with modifications and installation of antennas and equipment has been received from Tarpon towers for the Laketown site. The modifications and antenna installation will begin on June 12, 2017. Expected completion of all by end of June, 2017
- ii. Modifications to the Dispatch tower in progress. Expected completion by June 12, 2017. Microwave dishes installation is complete
- iii. Microwave equipment is installed at all sites.

4. Open Issues

i. GPS position information implementation is still not defined. Issue stems from the fact the data stream needs to run through the MPSCS ANS and MPSCS does not currently have sufficient ports to provide this to Allegan County. MPSCS and Motorola are working on a solution that will provide GPS services for the entire state, which will also satisfy the Allegan County requirements. This is a higher level issue that needs to be elevated and addressed by Motorola and MPSCS senior management. A meeting is scheduled for June 15, 2017 that will include those management personnel to drive this
