Re: Sustainable Business Park (SBP) Update

As requested, below is a short summary regarding the status of the planning, approval and development of the SBP on 250 acres of property owned by Kent County in Dorr Township, Allegan County immediately south of the existing South Kent Landfill.

In June 2020, the Kent County Purchasing Department issued a request for proposals seeking an "anchor" tenant company who would commit to divert at least 50% of the existing landfill content. Nine proposals were received in September and since then DPW narrowed a select to two company proposals. Since September, DPW staff and a consultant team have analyzed the validity of the two company proposals, they have submitted revised proposals with more detail and site visits to facilities developed and operated by the companies has been completed.

A work session with the Kent County Board of Commissioners regarding the status of the SBP project will take place on Thursday, August 26. Starting in September similar sessions will occur with the Dorr Township Board of Trustees, Allegan County, its solid waste planning committee, as well as Byron Township, and the many stakeholder committees we've been using to help guide us through this process.

DPW staff and the business/infrastructure consultant team will present an anchor tenant recommendation to the Kent County Board of Public works at its September 2 board meeting. It is anticipated the anchor tenant will invest at least \$150 million and employ around 100 people to operate a state-of-the-art municipal solid waste sorting facility and for the creation of products which use these feedstocks. Securing the investment and job creation of the anchor tenant is dependent upon Kent County securing approvals and to construct necessary infrastructure to the SBP site.

We're anticipating requesting approval from the BPW in October to negotiate a project development agreement that will provide a 30-month timeline to work with all stakeholders for

the approvals needed to break ground and move into a construction phase. As planned now, all infrastructure municipal and private utility provider approvals need to be secured between now and mid-2022 with final design and construction occurring in 2023. We expect the anchor tenant to commence operation not later than the 1st quarter of 2025.
