#### 1. Financials

**Financial Statements** 

Gildea is working to make a balanced budget this year. Revenues were down for quarter 1 & 2; Gildea reports we are \$20,000 down. Currently for quarter 3 we are up on revenues. Again there will be effect on revenues next years as many pavilion reservations moved to 2021. Gildea reports the expenditures are on track; with staff starting late it saved on payroll, gasoline and other expenses.

b. Quarterly Revenue Comparison Revenues were down for quarter 1 & 2; Gildea reports we are \$20,000 down. Currently for quarter 3 we are up on revenues.

### **INFORMATIONAL/DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

1. Parks Updates – Gildea went through each park and discussed what was occurring (pros/cons) in each park.

Gun Lake – very busy. Sold a lot of new season passes for Gun Lake

Bysterveld – trails and playground are staying well used

Dumont – extremely busy – having some issues with parking and overcrowding

Litlejohn Lake – busier than it has been in long time. Users at beach and accessing walling trails

Ely Lake Campground – again staying busy on the weekends. Quite a few homeless people staying at park

Silver Creek Campground – staying steady with equestrian and no equestrian users.

West Side Park – staying busy. Still having beach issues.

Gildea stated that parks is short three staff members (one maintenance and two park rangers). Gildea reviewed the upcoming special events and park programs that are scheduled. The Benefit Ride at Silver Creek in April was rescheduled to August, and the CMO Ride in May was rescheduled to the end of October.

- 2. Trowbridge Dam Area 1<sup>st</sup> draft concept designs/recreational use Gildea went over the concept designs that were attached in the agenda packet and asked for feedback:
  - Would like to see campground as many kayakers enjoy kayaking and staying the night along the river.
  - Like concept 2 with boat launch up and down of where dam area was
  - Like concept 2 with boat launches but would also like to see ADA accessible kayak launches installed by both boat launches (many people agreed with this)
  - Most don't thing soccer field (concept three) would be needed or best use of this land. If didn't do campground then liked concept 4.
  - Likes having walking trails around the property
  - Liked the education area
  - Thought it was a good idea to have day use area (pavilion/playground) at front of the park.
  - Worries that campground would be used by others/homeless and not available for kayak users.
  - Recognizes higher maintenance costs and more operation al staff need if campground is installed.
