**BROWNFIELD REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY—AUTHORIZE BROWNFIELD PLAN DEVELOPMENT/DEVELOP ROCK TENN DEMOLITION PROPOSAL**

**19/ WHEREAS**, on July 9, 2020, the Board of Commissioners (Board) authorized the County Administrator to prepare a Request for Proposal (RFP) package for the demolition of the remaining buildings inclusive of a bid alternative to add the removal of the foundations; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 30, 2020, the Allegan County Brownfield Redevelopment Authority met and by motion recommended the County develop a brownfield plan and RFP for demolition simultaneously so that all eligible expenses to be recovered; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 8, 2020 the Executive Director of Services presented three options to proceed with the RFP for the demolition of the former Rock Tenn paper mill; and

**WHEREAS**, a recommendation was made to select option #2 which states, "Hire a consultant to develop a BRP and an RFP for demolition and removal. The County would proceed immediately with the BRP which would include development and release of a RFP (after the BRP is approved) initially utilizing Tax Reversion Funds or other County funds (plan development and RFP costs up to \$60,000 eligible for reimbursement). All work is expected to be recuperated through financing tools, primarily expected to be Brownfield Tax Incremental Financing."; and

**WHEREAS**, Environmental Consulting & Technology (ECT) an environmental contractor has completed the Phase I, Phase II and Due Care plan specific to the former Rock Tenn property, the Executive Director of Services recommends the County proceed with an agreement for ECT to develop the BRP to expedite the time-line.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board approves the recommendation of "option 2" as outlined above; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Health has identified a need for a mobile examination, testing and vaccination clinic, in the fight against COVID-19 and other diseases, as well as disease prevention; and

**WHEREAS**, a mobile clinic would be considered a capital asset, and more specifically a vehicle; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 8, 2020, the Board directed that any activity that would serve to increase the size of the County's fleet must be brought before the Board of Commissioners for consideration; and

**WHEREAS**, funding in the amount of up to \$225,000 has become available to pursue a mobile clinic initiative.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board authorizes the County Administrator to purchase the vehicle using grant funds not to exceed \$225,000 through the facilitation of the Transportation Department and to determine the most appropriate process for purchase to meet both County policy and funding time parameters, this includes utilizing any cooperative agreement or bid processes recently performed within the region; and

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board authorizes the addition of a Public Health mobile clinic to the County fleet list; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the County fleet list clearly identify that grant funding was the method of acquisition for this vehicle, and

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the County Administrator is authorized to sign the necessary documents on behalf of the County and that the Executive Director of Finance is authorized to make the necessary budget adjustments to complete this action.
