The Allegan County Drain Commissioner will meet on the above date, time and location to receive construction bids for the Big Lake Drain. Bids will then be opened and publicly announced. The Big Lake Drain project will be let in 1 section as follows, having the length, average depth and width as set forth:

2,149 linear feet of enclosed storm sewer of 16" diameter at an average depth of 4 feet

1,530 linear feet of enclosed storm sewer of 16" diameter at an average depth of 0 feet

This Notice of Letting, the plans, specifications and bid proposal shall be considered a part of the Contract. The Contract will be let in accordance with the **Contract Documents available to interested parties through the QuestCDN online bid portal (questcdn.com)**. Contract Documents can be downloaded after April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021 by entering Quest Project Number 7792868 on the portal's project search page. Copies of Contract Documents may only be obtained upon payment of a \$15 *non-refundable* deposit through the QuestCDN portal.

A non-mandatory on-site pre-bid meeting will be held May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. beginning at the corner of 120<sup>th</sup> Ave and Pleasant View Ave.

**Bids will be made and received through Quest CDN** upon payment of an additional \$30 non-refundable bidding fee through the QuestCDN portal. Bidding instructions will be available to those who download Contract Documents through the QuestCDN portal. Any responsible person wanting to bid on the above-mentioned work will be required to deposit bid security (bid bond, certified check, or cashier's check – cash is not acceptable - payable to Allegan County Drain Commissioner) in the amount of no less than five percent (5%) of the bid specified in the Contract Documents as a guarantee that they will enter into a contract and furnish the required bonds as prescribed by the contract specifications and applicable law and within ten (10) days after the award of the contract, execute a contract or agreement and file necessary insurance and other bonds, if selected as the accepted bidder. If the selected awardee fails to properly execute the necessary bonds, agreement, and insurance requirement, the bid bond shall be deemed forfeited to the owner as liquidated damages. All bids shall remain open for 90 days after the day of the Bid Opening, but the Drain Commissioner reserves the right at their sole discretion to release any bid and bid security before that date.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work and meeting all conditions represented in the Instructions to Bidders. The Contract completion date and the terms of payment will be announced at the Bid Opening. If no satisfactory bids are received, we reserve the right to reject any and all bids and to adjourn to a time and location as we shall announce.
