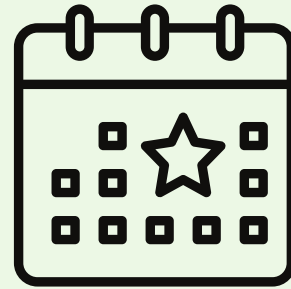


# Electronics (e-waste)
