ORDER OF NECESSITY

A meeting having been held by the Board of Determination, composed of Roger VanVolkinburg, Chris Machiela, Richard Hutchins, and Pam Brown, Alternate, at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 21, 2022 at the Dorr Township Hall, 4196 18th Street, Dorr, Michigan, being the time and place fixed in the Notice of Meeting of Board of Determination, notice was duly served, published and posted as required by law; and at said meeting CHRIS MACHIELA was elected Chairperson and RICHARD HUTCHINS was elected Secretary, and all persons owning lands liable to assessment for benefits or whose lands shall be crossed by said drain and any district or municipality affected having been given an opportunity to appear and be heard on the question being considered of whether the drain prayed for in a Freeholders of the Township Petition for maintenance and improvement for a county drain to be known as the Bates Drain, is necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare in accordance with Sections 72 and 191 of Act No. 40, P.A. 1956, as amended; and the Board of Determination after having heard the evidence offered and having made its determination upon the necessity of the drain and whether the same is necessary and conducive to public health, convenience of welfare;

It Is Hereby Ordered and Determined that the drain to be known as Bates Drain as prayed for in the Petition dated June 1, 2020 (check one) is **is** **not** necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare.
