Order of Practicability

BLACK CREEK OF ZEELAND INTERCOUNTY DRAIN
(Ottawa and Allegan Counties)

WHEREAS, the Black Creek of Zeeland Intercounty Drain Drainage Board met on April 13, 2022 to consider the petition, dated May 20, 2021, for maintenance and improvement of an intercounty drain pursuant to Chapter 8 of Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended, to determine the sufficiency of the petition to convey jurisdiction, go over the route of the intercounty drain, and to further determine whether the maintenance and improvement of the intercounty drain is practicable; and

WHEREAS, said Drainage Board after hearing the evidence offered made its determination upon the sufficiency of the petition and whether the proposed drain project is practicable.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DETERMINED by a majority vote of the Drainage Board, that the petition is sufficient to convey jurisdiction as provided in Chapter 8 of Public Act 40 of 1956, as amended.

IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED AND DETERMINED by a majority vote of the Drainage Board that the proposed drain project as set forth in the petition is practicable.
