# **DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

- 1. Silver Creek Campsite Usage Designated Equestrian vs Non Equestrian Campsites - Discussed the issues with equestrian camper's vs non-equestrian campers. Will monitor through out 2022 and see if increased Ranger presence and a having a camp host can help in educating non-equestrians about etiquette around horses.
- 2. Park Entrance Signage -Gildea went over two designs that were found in the Agenda packet. The parks board unanimously agreed to move forward with design 1. Gildea will get mock -ups and quotes for every park.
- 3. Park Fee Structure Review
  - a. Pavilion (1/2 day vs full day)
  - b. Season Pass
    - i. Separate boating vs equestrian pass
    - ii. Kayakers/canoes vs boats that use ramp

Gildea went over the current structure for both pavilion and season passes. They are not suggesting any changes to pavilion structure as the half days provide good customer service. Discussion occurred around how we could better track usage by separating the season pass so there is one for boating and one for equestrian trails.

Motion made by Brown, seconded by Metz to separate our current season pass, no longer having a season pass that covers both, and each boating and equestrian trail have its own season pass. The motion carried.
